Hazel Hurdle Making

Learn how to make a traditional woven hazel hurdle for garden, farm or woodland use on a one day course organised by Woodnet and Plumpton College at Flimwell.

Your tutor, Alan Sage, will guide you through the process discussing selection and storage of materials and demonstrating the practical techniques. You will then work on your hurdle to take home at the end of the day. You will make a hurdle about 4ft x 4ft but you can vary the size to suit your needs.

The next course is on Thursday **19 April 2012** at The Woodland Enterprise Centre, Flimwell, East Sussex, TN5 7PR.
