## Managing Woodland with Hand Tools

Learn how to manage woodland with hand tools on a practical one day course organised by Woodnet and Plumpton College at Flimwell.

Your tutor, John Waller, will explain the woodland management activities that can be carried out by hand and the benefits of using hand tools, as an alternative to or in addition to using machinery. You will learn how to fell and cut trees safely and deal with them efficiently on the ground; how to coppice and fell using hand saws, billhooks and axes; how to use ropes; and how to cleave and cut felled timber. There will also be advice on buying, selecting and maintaining tools.
